- Sandra Schneider, MD, FACEP (ACEP Section Liaison) and Ms. Julie Wassom (ACEP Section Administrative Coordinator) were introduced and thanked for their incredible contributions to the section.
- o Rami Khoury, MD was introduced as the ACEP Board of Directors Liaison to our section.

• Ongoing Business:

- Cross Collaboration with Other Sections/Interest Groups
 - The topic of collaborating with the Event Medicine Section was again broached.
 A suggestion for finding a speaker of combined interest was presented; Dr.
 Jeffrey Feden will follow-up on that matter.
 - The Ultrasound Section was another area mentioned as ripe for crosstalk. They
 will be contacted to determine how we might be able to lend our
 musculoskeletal ultrasound prowess to their educational offerings.
- o Engagement/Involvement with the National Athletic Trainers' Association (NATA)
 - They have inquired about how to get athletic trainers more involved in emergency medicine/the emergency department.
 - There was a conversation about their role in musculoskeletal-based clinics and orthopaedic urgent cares as well.
 - A proposal was advanced to draft a joint policy statement outlining their goals and how we (as a section) can help them achieve those goals.

Sports Medicine Mentorship/Engagement

- There was a discussion about where e-mails from interested individuals who reach out through the ACEP website should directed.
- One proposal suggested dividing up the e-mails by geographic regions and assigning them to interested faculty.
- Ultimately, it was determined that the section secretary would receive the emails and maintain a list of faculty who are willing to engage these individuals.
 The requests for mentorship/engagement would then be forwarded to those faculty members accordingly.

New Business

- o Sports Medicine Section Dues Fund Status
 - This fund does not roll over; the current balance is unclear but will be assessed by Dr. Schneider.
 - We can utilize the funds on a project or to augment a meeting. There was a
 discussion regarding whether it could be used to fund a guest speaker and/or
 food at section meetings. This too will be investigated by Dr. Schneider for
 further clarity.
 - Section grants were also referenced as an avenue for securing additional funding to be used for apps (e.g., a point-of-care tool app), programs, etc. At this time, it appears that section grant funding has been paused; however, the section leadership will investigate this matter further and determine when such grants may become available again.
 - Of note, the fiscal year concludes in July; we must allocate our funds by then.

Parent Education Courses

- The idea of conducting community events annually at the ACEP Scientific
 Assembly to teach basic skills to parents attending sporting events was raised.
- A similar concept for physician parents was proposed.
- The section leadership will clarify the status of section grants as an avenue to help fund such endeavors.

Future ACEP Sports Medicine Annual Section Meetings

 It was suggested that the annual section meeting be conducted via a hybrid model (i.e., both in-person and virtual) to optimize attendance and participation.

Additional Virtual Meetings

- We will look to host virtual meetings in mid-winter and early summer to continue the momentum of the group.
- Offline modalities (e.g., text messaging, Slack, etc.) will be explored as other ways to optimize our productivity.
