(PHOTOS AND VIDEOS)

TIPS THAT WORK BEST FOR PHOTOS & VIDEOS

VERTICAL OR HORIZONTAL?

- Horizontal (Landscape): Best for large groups or landscapes.
- Vertical (Portrait): Best for small groups, single people, or tall objects.

CLEAN YOUR LENS

Wipe your camera lens with a soft cloth or your shirt before recording. This helps to remove any smudges.

USE LIGHT TO YOUR ADVANTAGE

- Make sure the **light** is on the subject's face, not behind them.
- Natural light works best when available.
- Avoid filming the subject directly under a light source.

ANGLES AND CAMERA FOCUS

- Experiment with different angles to find the best way to capture you or your subject.
- Tap your screen to focus the camera. This helps avoid blurry photos and keeps your subject in focus.

WHAT TO CAPTURE

- "Let's take a selfie!" Or ask someone to take a pic of you and your friends
- You or a group at any of the sessions or receptions
- Groups of people on the stairs at Capitol Hill
- Selfie or picture of your chapter in the waiting area or office of a congress person
- Picture speaking or posing with a Congress person with his/her permission

TIPS THAT WORK BEST FOR VIDEO ONLY

CAPTURE THE BEST AUDIO

• Your phone's built-in mic works, but an external mic gives **better sound quality.** Also, location matters so choose a quiet spot to record.

ALL ABOUT THE FRAMING

- Stay **centered in the frame** and look at the camera as if you're talking to someone directly
- Keep the camera at waist or chest height and try to avoid excessive movement.
- Avoid cutting off heads in the frame. You want a reasonable amount of room from the person's head to top of the screen's edge.

USE A TRIPOD OR STURDY SURFACE

• Avoid shaky footage by using a tripod or place your camera on a stable surface.

KNOW WHAT YOU WANT TO SAY

- **Have a plan** for what you want to say. Write down your ideas to stay on track.
- Be clear about your message and what you want your audience to take away.

WHAT TO CAPTURE

- Video pan of a busy room at LAC or a reception
- Cheers video with friends
- Clip of a speaker
- Selfie video walking around Capitol Hill
- Clip of **chapter/group** walking up the steps or around Capitol Hill
- Talking to the camera with a summary of the issues you are focused on and why it's important for other EPs to be at LAC/go to Capitol Hill
